### 2. Installation

**a)** carefully take a luminaire out of the box and put it on a stable surface

**b)** power supply connection:

- put the feeding cable through the hole in the base of a suspension

- take suspension flap off

- connect the wire as shown on a cube

c) mounting of the suspension on a ceiling:


- luminaire's suspension should be mounted on the ceiling with two plugs with a spacing as shown on a picture (C)


**d)** pull the loose wire through the hole in a suspension flap and plug in into bipolar cube


**e)** drag suspension lines thorough the hole in a suspension flap as well as lines' fastenings and screw the lines' stoppers on

**f)** tighten controls in the sleeve assembly lines on the back of a luminaire's housing

g) screw universal suspension into the ceiling, unscrew external nut lightly, put the line in until obtaining optimum level of suspension and screw nut on.Putting line deeper cause luminaire lifting. In order to lower luminaire loosen nut
