

2. Assembly

a) remove carefully luminaire from packaging and put in safety and stable place

b) choose the phase of reflector and connect the power wire according to signs at power cube



c) connect wires of external power supply accordingly into K3 cube

d) assembly of fittings and end caps:

- in first luminaire of the line put the closing plate and screw from the upper side with screws
- then put fixings (linear connectors) into the luminaires so they join two side reflectors with eight screws
- electrical connection between side luminaire are made with use of male and female cubes



e) fluorescent lamp mounting:

- lamps of correct power put to the luminaire
- rotate fluorescent lamp 90 degrees

f) suspension regulation:

- height suspension regulation is done with handle move on the linear connectors and end cups

!! Gauge of the suspension equals the lenght of luminaire it is mounted on. All linear connectors and closing plates must be suspended **!!**

- balance the luminaire by regulation of chain to the next hole of handle
